




SIAG/FME Membership History




Overall SIAG Membership




SIAG/FME Member Demographics




SIAG/FME Members By Employer Type




SIAG/FME Membership by Gender







SIAM/FM Conference Budgets

- Conference is expected to be close to self-sufficient in terms of direct costs
- Containing costs is difficult (many other moving parts beyond picking the city location)
- Registration fees are set late in the planning process
- □ SIAM covers most of the overhead (staff costs, etc)
