




#### **SIAG Dynamical Systems Membership History**







### **DS**Web Registered Users






### **DSWeb Usage Trend by Month**













## DSWeb Top 21 Represented Countries (Out of 90 Total)












### Location DS17 – Requests for Proposals

- ► SIAM Office
  - ▶ Jim Crowley, Linda Thiel, Kirsten Wilden
- Criteria
  - Ability to accommodate approximately 1,000 attendees
  - Ability to accommodate our meeting space requirements
